To achieve the mission, Valley Family Center provides individual, couple and family therapy for adults and children, programs for victims of domestic violence, a batterers' intervention program, anger management and parent education for adults, and the Learning Center after school tutoring program. Culturally competent counseling and education are provided in English and Spanish and meet the needs of the low income community. Last year, Valley Family Center served 965 unduplicated clients through on-site programs, and an additional 456 through outreach and education about domestic violence.
