Valley Family Center was founded in 1987 with the mission to provide counseling and educational services that facilitate personal growth, strengthen the family unit, and protect human dignity for all persons in need. To achieve the mission, Valley Family Center provides individual, couple and family therapy for adults and children, programs for victims of domestic violence, a batterers' intervention program and parent education for adults, and the Learning Center after school tutoring program for children. Culturally competent counseling and education are provided in English and Spanish to meet the needs of the low income community. Last year, Valley Family Center served 965 unduplicated clients through on-site programs, and an additional 456 through outreach and education about domestic violence. Position Summary

The Associate Marriage and Family Therapist will:

- Conduct initial assessments, clinical case management, and crisis intervention
- Utilizing information gathered and knowledge of diagnostic criteria from DSM 5, assign diagnosis to clients and create appropriate treatment plan
- Provide therapy to adults and children (individual, couples, families and groups)
- Conform to all legal and ethical standards applicable to psychotherapy or counseling providers as required by state law, agency requirements and the profession
- Maintain confidentiality of records relating to client's treatment
- Attend two-hour group supervision per week and one-hour individual supervision as necessary
- Attend training and clinical case presentations
- Adhere to Valley Family Center's policies and procedures
